## Tournament Rules/Format

- All 2015-16 Volleyball Canada Rules will be in effect for this tournament.
- The Mikasa VUL 500 will be the official competition ball for this age category.
- **Triple-Ball format will be used for ALL competitions.**
  - A full description of the Triple Ball format is found in the **Program Guide, pp. 14 – 16**

  - **Mandatory 6–0 system: setter in position 2 or 3 (determined by the coach @ the beginning of the match)**
  - **NO SWITCHING allowed.** Players are not allowed to change positions, in defensive or offensive situations. Setting from the other players, except position 2 or 3, can only be performed to correct an error
- **Serve/Receive Rule (unchanged from 2015 season)**
  - Receiving a serve overhand with the fingers (like a set or a volley), is **ILLEGAL** for categories 16U and younger.
  - Any such attempt will be called by the official, regardless of the quality of the conduct.
- **NO libero.**
- **ALL** athletes will start in either the 1<sup>st</sup> **OR** 2<sup>nd</sup> set.

ALL 3 sets are played	Best 2 of 3 sets are played
Substitutions <b>ONLY</b> occur in the event of an injury.	Substitutions <b>MAY</b> occur once 1 of the teams has reached 15 points, OR in the event of an injury.
Athletes who did not start the 3 <sup>rd</sup> set <b>WILL</b> be substituted into the game after teams switch sides (@ 8 pts.).	Athletes who did not start the 3 <sup>rd</sup> set <b>MAY</b> be substituted into the game at any time during the set.

- All games will be played Rally Point to 25 (no cap) - you must win by 2 points.
- All **three (3) sets are played in round robin** – the first two (2) to 25 points, the third to 15 points.
- The third game of the Best of Three Matches will be played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points (no cap)
- Head Coaches must be certified a Development Coach (Level 1) in Volleyball at the time of registration. First time coaches will be given a one-year grace period to complete their Development Coach certification.

### Officiating

Your team will provide Minor Officials for each game in which you are scheduled to play. Your team must provide **1 Scorekeeper** and **1 Linesman** per match. If players assume either of these roles, they are still eligible to play and may be substituted in to play. Your team may wish to have a few parent volunteers take care of this duty for your team.

### Tournament Format

Based on Volleyball Canada Rules, if two or more teams are tied at the end of round robin play, the following criteria will be applied in order:

- a) The team having the best ratio of **won/lost matches**, considering matches **between tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- b) The team having the best ratio of **won/lost games**, considering matches played **between the tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- c) The team having the best ratio of **won/lost games**, considering **all matches of the round**, will be ranked higher;
- d) The team having the best ratio of **points for/against**, considering games played **between tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- e) The team having the best ratio of **points for/against**, considering **all games played during the round**, will be ranked higher;
- f) As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)

## **Match Preparation**

- Please have your team ready to play on time. Once all teams have played one match, you will have only a **five-minute ball warm up** on court before the start of your next match.
- Your co-operation would be appreciated in moving our tournament ahead of schedule if the opportunity presents itself.
- All games shall start on time as scheduled. Failure of a team to be ready to play at the scheduled time will be penalized by the loss of the first set by forfeit. A further 15 minutes will be allowed before the forfeiture of the second set.
- Teams must supply their own warm up balls.
- Coaches please fill in your rosters and sign the score sheet prior to each match.
