Here are the results for this past weekend's 15U Women Conexus Provincial Volleyball Championships in Saskatoon and Warman...

Total team effort for Royal Elite to win Provincial Championship

The Regina QCVC Royal Elite claimed Tier 1 Gold Sunday on Shaw TV, winning the final 25-10, 24-26, 15-5 over the Saskatoon Smash. The Royal Elite came in as the number one seed in the tournament, and Head Coach Rob Hoffman said it took the entire lineup to keep their status and win a Provincial title. "It was a full team effort all weekend," said Hoffman, "We played all twelve athletes all the way through. We went to three sets so many times all season, but the girls fought through and really deserve this as a group". In the Tier 1 Bronze medal match, the Saskatoon JCVC Fire topped the Prince Albert Optimist Toppers En Fuego in three close sets, 25-21, 19-25, 15-13. The Royal Elite and Smash each went through the tournament undefeated, but each played a number of tough matches to get to the final. After winning Pool A, the Royal Elite knocked off Muenster VC, Moose Jaw Element Panthers, and in a semi-final En Fuego in three sets. The Smash number two seed in the tournament, won Pool B and then beat Waldheim United, Lanigan Blue, and in a semi-final the Saskatoon JCVC Fire to get to the final.

In Tier 2, the Battleford VC Blaze came back to beat the Lloydminster Rustlers 19-25, 25-18, 16-14 to win Gold. The Blaze, fourth in SUBWAY Sask Cup #2, won Pool E but lost a playoff match to eventual Tier 1 Bronze medalist JCVC Fire to drop to Tier 2. The Swift Current Junior Sundogs took Tier 2 Bronze with a 25-22, 13-25, 15-13 win over Waldheim United.

In Tier 3, the Rosetown Athletes Haven topped the Estevan Extreme 15-25, 25-20, 15-12 for Gold. The Prince Albert Volleyball Club Fusion won Bronze with a 25-21, 25-14 victory over the Saskatoon Dynamo T-Rex. The Warman Volleyball Club claimed Tier 4 Gold with a 25-15, 25-13 win over the La Loche Lakers, while the Regina Volleyball Club Gold took Tier 4 Bronze after a 25-20, 16-25, 15-8 win over Birch Hills Barracudas. In Tier 5, the Melfort Storm took home Gold after a narrow 25-21, 26-24 win over the Regina QCVC Black, while the Martensville Outerlimits Blue took Bronze by beating the Saskatoon Dynamo Dynamite 20-25, 25-19, 15-10.
