### TOURNAMENT NOTES

#### A. SEEDING

Seeding is done by adding **the 2 highest point values from Sask Cup 1, Sask Cup 2 and Sask Cup 3.**

#### B. OFFICIATING

All teams will provide Minor Officials for each game in which you are scheduled to play. You must provide 1 Scorekeeper and 1 Linesman per match. These players are still eligible to play and may be substituted in to play. You may wish to have a few parent volunteers take care of this duty for your team.

#### C. TIE BREAKING

Based on Volleyball Canada Rules, if two or more teams are tied at the end of round robin play, the following criteria will be applied in order:

- a) The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches between tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- b) The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- c) The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering all matches of the round, will be ranked higher;
- d) The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- e) The team having the best ratio of point for/against, considering all games played during the round, will be ranked higher;
- f) As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)





#### D. MATCH PREPARATION

- Please have your team ready to play on time. Once all teams have played one match, you will have only a five-minute ball warm up on court before the start of your next match. If the tournament gets behind schedule referees may limit on court warmup to three minutes, providing both teams have already played a match that day.
- Teams need to be ready to play on time, even if your court is behind schedule. We may move your game to another court.
- All games shall start on time as scheduled. Failure of a team to be ready to play at the scheduled time will be penalized by the loss of the first set by forfeit. A further 15 minutes will be allowed before the forfeiture of the second set.
- Teams must supply their own warm up balls.
- Coaches please fill in your rosters and sign the score sheet prior to each match.

#### E. TOURNAMENT RULES

All 2017-18 Volleyball Canada Rules will be in effect for this tournament, including the following changes/variations:

- All games will be played Rally Point to 25 (no cap) - you must win by 2 points.
- The third game of the Best of Three Matches will be played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points (no cap).
- 16U Women will utilize the 6-limited substitution rule with libero.
- The net height for 16U Girls will be **2.24 m**.
- The ball used will be the Sask Volleyball official ball for 16U Girls, the **Mikasa MIP300**.

#### F. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- All teams will begin the tournament in **either Division 1, Division 2 or Division 3**.
- For more information please read the details found in the next pages.

#### G. PROOF OF AGE

A Coaches' check-in will be at the Henk Ruys Soccer Centre on **FRIDAY, APRIL 27<sup>th</sup>** from **4:30 – 8:30 pm**. All coaches are to come between this time to check in their teams.

Coaches will need to show one **government issued document** for each athlete (original or photocopy, drivers licence, health card or birth certificate) at the **Henk Ruys Technical Office (Officials room)**, **PRIOR TO THEIR FIRST MATCH**. Sorry, if documentation isn't produced athletes will **NOT** be allowed to play. Coaches can pick up their **coaching package** including the **official team roster** and **bench wristbands** at this time. **All Head and Assistant Coaches** must wear their wristband and also have completed the requirements for **Respect in Sport** before they will be permitted on the bench.

If you require a **late check-in**, contact Cara at the Sask Volleyball office prior to **Wednesday, April 25<sup>th</sup>**.

**There will be no check-in provided on Saturday.**





## H. CERTIFICATION

All **Head Coaches** who **DO NOT** meet the **requirements** will be required to pay the appropriate fine at the Technical Office by cash, or cheque, before their team will be allowed to begin competing. Payments can be made by credit card in advance by contacting Marcus at the Sask Volleyball office at 306-527-3834.

- **Head Coaches** must present their **verified official roster** prior to **each match** and the **NCCP** number is to be recorded on the score sheet each match, (coaches will receive a copy of their official roster at check-in).

## I. PARKING

Parking is limited at Henk Ruys. Parking is **not permitted** beside and in front of the Saskatoon Civic Centre, violators may be ticketed. Overflow parking is available in the Mall of Lawson Heights.

## J. MEDICAL ROOM

There will be a medical room onsite for athletes requiring first-aid. If you anticipate requiring attention, we encourage you to bring your own supplies (ie. tape). There will be a **\$5 charge** per roll of tape.

## K. PHOTOS

TeamWorks Photo will be taking a Team Photo of every team at the event for the Sask Volleyball archives. You will receive an email early next week indicating a timeslot that has been reserved for your team, which will be either immediately before or after one of your matches early in the tournament. If that timeslot doesn't work for you, you can just drop in to the booth and TeamWorks Photo will fit you in.

## L. WARM-UPS

While Team A is running through their hitting warmup, Team B is either at their own bench or they can be doing a controlled ball handling warmup behind Team A.

## M. FOOD

Refrain from bringing in crockpots and/or large size coolers. Teams are also asked not to create a buffet style food setup.

## N. MERCHANDISE

Just Volleyball will once again be on-site to sell volleyball clothing and equipment.

## O. DRESSING ROOMS

Sask Volleyball will be sending out information regarding dressing rooms at all of the Championships.

### FORMAT

1) Initial **Round Robin** – (see master draw).

---

2) At the **conclusion** of the initial Round Robin Pool Play,

a) **Division 1:** All teams in **Pool A** and **Pool B** advance to **Division 1 playoff**.

b) **Division 2:**

- All teams in **Pool C** advance to **Division 2 Tier 1 Playoff**.
- **Top 2** teams in each **Pool D** and **Pool E** also advance to **Division 2 Tier 1 Playoff**.
- Teams finishing **3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup>** in **Pool D** and **Pool E** advance to **Division 2 Tier 2 Playoff**.

c) **Division 3:**

- **Top 2** teams in each **Pool F, Pool G** and **Pool H** advance to **Division 3 Tier 1 Playoff**.
- Teams that finished **3<sup>rd</sup> in Pool F, 3<sup>rd</sup> in Pool G, 3<sup>rd</sup> in Pool H** and **4<sup>th</sup> in Pool H** advance to a **Division 3 crossover**.
  - \* **Winners** advance to **Division 3 Tier 1 Playoff**.
  - \* **Losers** advance to **Division 3 Tier 2 Playoff**.
- The rest of the teams in Division 3 will advance directly to **Division 3 Tier 2 Playoff**.
