Tournament Notes

- Seeding is done using the 17U and 18U Women 2016 Sask Cup 2 results.

Tournament Rules/Format

- All 2015-16 Volleyball Canada Rules will be in effect for this tournament.
- All games will be played Rally Point to 25 (no cap) - you must win by 2 points.
- The third game of the Best of Three Matches will be played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points (no cap).

Note: Your teams final placing at the conclusion of this Sask Cup 3 tournament will determine your placing at the Provincial Championships.

- 1) The top 8 18U teams at the conclusion of Sask Cup 3 will compete in Division 1 in the 18U category at the Provincial Championship.**
 - 2) The top 8 17U teams at the conclusion of Sask Cup 3 will compete in Division 1 in the 17U category at the Provincial Championship.**
 - 3) The remainder of the 17U and 18U teams will compete in a combined Division 2 17U and 18U category.**

Officiating

Your team will provide Minor Officials for each game in which you are scheduled to play. Your team must provide **1 Scorekeeper** and **1 Linesman** per match. If players assume either of these roles, they are still eligible to play and may be substituted in to play. Your team may wish to have a few parent volunteers take care of this duty for your team.

Tie-Breaking Procedure

Based on Volleyball Canada Rules, if two or more teams are tied at the end of round robin play, the following criteria will be applied in order:

- a) The team having the best ratio of won/lost **matches**, considering matches **between tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- b) The team having the best ratio of won/lost **games**, considering matches played **between the tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- c) The team having the best ratio of won/lost **games**, considering **all matches of the round**, will be ranked higher;
- d) The team having the best ratio of **points** for/against, considering games played **between tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- e) The team having the best ratio of **points** for/against, considering **all games played during the round**, will be ranked higher;
- f) As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)

Match Preparation

- Please have your team ready to play on time. Once all teams have played one match, you will have only a five-minute ball warm up on court before the start of your next match.
- Your co-operation would be appreciated in moving our tournament ahead of schedule if the opportunity presents itself.
- All games shall start on time as scheduled. Failure of a team to be ready to play at the scheduled time will be penalized by the loss of the first set by forfeit. A further 15 minutes will be allowed before the forfeiture of the second set.
- Teams must supply their own warm up balls.
- Coaches please fill in your rosters and sign the score sheet prior to each match.
