## **DENNIS POMEROY**

Dennis became involved with Sask Volleyball in the early 1970's. He became a local certified ref in 1971 and eventually received a National level in 1984.

Dennis served as the Executive Director of Sask Volleyball, from 2002-2007. He did an excellent job in showing a high level of ability in administering to the needs of referees in Saskatchewan and Canada, as well as getting Sask Volleyball back on track and functioning as a successful Provincial Governing body and leader throughout Canada.

Dennis carried Canada's colors on the International scene as a referee. He was a Canadian representative on the referee committee at the 1991 North America, Central America and Caribbean volleyball federation, and NORCECA Championship in Regina SK. Dennis also represented Canada on the referee committee in 1999 at the World Junior Women's Championship in Saskatoon/Edmonton.

Dennis continued to impact his referee career, gaining a spot as a referee manager at the FIVB Beach in Toronto 2000-2002. The following year Dennis was involved with the PanAm Games Beach Volleyball in Winnipeg 2003 managing referees and was NOC (National Officials Chair) for Volleyball Canada for many years. Dennis was also nominated for Jury in 2003 and 2007 during the FISU Games. He served on the Referee Management team at numerous Volleyball Canada Nationals Championships from 2003 – 2016.

Dennis continued to impact the volleyball community as the Referee Development Coordinator for Sask Volleyball from 2014 – 2017, where his passion for the sport, love of teaching and attention to detail and organization were all blended together in the work and effort he put forth in educating referees and instilling excellence in all who were around him.
