On January 1st, 2014, Volleyball Canada complied with the Coaches Association of Canada's (CAC) NCCP Professional Development policy. Coaches who are "Certified" within any context now receive credit within the Locker database for approved professional development experiences. To maintain certification, certified Development Coaches & Advanced Development Coaches will need to accrue 20 points over a period of 5 years.
