TOURNAMENT NOTES:

A. Seeding

Seeding is done using the **16UW 2017 Sask Cup 1 results**.

B. Officiating

All teams will provide Minor Officials for each game in which you are scheduled to play. You must provide 1 Scorekeeper and 1 Linesman per match. These players are still eligible to play and may be substituted in to play. You may wish to have a few parent volunteers take care of this duty for your team.



C. Tie Breaking

Based on Volleyball Canada Rules, if two or more teams are tied at the end of round robin play, the following criteria will be applied in order:

- a) The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches between tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- b) The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- c) The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering all matches of the round, will be ranked higher;
- d) The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- e) The team having the best ratio of point for/against, considering all games played during the round, will be ranked higher;
- f) As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)

D. Match Preparation

- Please have your team ready to play on time. Once all teams have played one match, you will have only a five-minute ball warm up on court before the start of your next match. If the tournament gets behind schedule referees may limit on court warmup to three minutes, providing both teams have already played a match that day.
- Teams need to be ready to play on time, even if your court is behind schedule. We may move your game to another court.
- All games shall start on time as scheduled. Failure of a team to be ready to play at the scheduled time will be penalized by the loss of the first set by forfeit. A further 15 minutes will be allowed before the forfeiture of the second set.
- Teams must supply their own warm up balls.
- Coaches please fill in your rosters and sign the score sheet prior to each match.

E. Tournament Rules

- All 2016-17 Volleyball Canada Rules will be in effect for this tournament.
- Serve Receive with an overhand motion using the fingers (volleying/setting the serve) is not permitted, regardless of the quality of the contact.
- 16U Women will utilize the 6-limited substitution rule with libero.
- All games will be played Rally Point to 25 (no cap) - you must win by 2 points.
- The third game of the Best of Three Matches will be played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points (no cap).

F. Tournament Format

- All teams will begin either in Division 1 or Division 2, based on their finish from Sask Cup 1.

FORMAT

1. Initial **Round Robin** for all pools.
(see **matches #1 to #52** on master draw).

2. a) Teams finishing **1st** in **Pools A** and **B** will play each other, (**match #53**) to determine 1st and 2nd place seeding for **Division 1 playoffs**. After this match these teams will advance to Division 1 playoffs, (**matches #59 to #70**).
- b) Teams finishing **2nd** in **Pools A** and **B** will play each other, (**match #54**) to determine 3rd and 4th place seeding for **Division 1 playoffs**. After this match these teams will advance to Division 1 playoffs, (**matches #59 to #70**).

- c) Teams finishing **3rd or 4th** from **Pools A and B** advance to **Division 1/2 Crossover** with teams finishing **1st** in **Pools C – F** on **Saturday**, (**matches #55 to #58**).
Winners of crossover advance to **Division 1 Playoffs**, (**matches #59 to #70**) on **Sunday**.
Losers of crossover advance to **Division 2 Tier 1 playoffs**, (**matches #71 to #82**) on **Sunday**.

3. Teams finishing **3rd or 4th** in **Pools C – F** advance to **Division 2 Tier 2 playoffs** on **Sunday**, (**matches #83 to #94**).

4. Teams finishing **5th** in **Pools C – F** advance to a **Division 2 consolation RePool GG** on **Sunday**, (**matches #95 to #100**). Each team's final standing in RePool GG will determine their placing at Sask Cup 2, (25th to 28th).
