A. Seeding

B. Officiating

Your team will provide Minor Officials for each game in which you are scheduled to play. Your team must provide **1 Scorekeeper** and **1 Linesman** per match. If players assume either of these roles, they are still eligible to play and may be substituted in to play. Your team may wish to have a few parent volunteers take care of this duty for your team.

C. Tie-Breaking Procedure

Based on Volleyball Canada Rules, if two or more teams are tied at the end of round robin play, the following criteria will be applied in order:

- a) The team having the best ratio of won/lost **matches**, considering matches **between tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- b) The team having the best ratio of won/lost **games**, considering matches played **between the tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- c) The team having the best ratio of won/lost **games**, considering **all matches of the round**, will be ranked higher;
- d) The team having the best ratio of **points** for/against, considering games played **between tied teams**, will be ranked higher;
- e) The team having the best ratio of **points** for/against, considering **all games played during the round**, will be ranked higher;
- f) As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)

D. Match Preparation

- Please have your team ready to play on time. Once all teams have played one match, you will have only a five-minute ball warm up on court before the start of your next match. If the tournament gets behind schedule referees may limit on court warmup to three minutes, providing both teams have already played a match that day.
- Teams need to be ready to play on time, even if your court is behind schedule. We may move your game to another court.
- All games shall start on time as scheduled. Failure of a team to be ready to play at the scheduled time will be penalized by the loss of the first set by forfeit. A further 15 minutes will be allowed before the forfeiture of the second set.
- Coaches please fill in your rosters and sign the score sheet prior to each match.

E. Tournament Rules

- All 2016-17 Volleyball Canada Rules will be in effect for this tournament
- Serve Receive with an overhand motion using the fingers (volleying/setting the serve) is not permitted, regardless of the quality of the contact.
- 16U Men will utilize the 12-limited substitution rule with NO libero.
- All games will be played Rally Point to 25 (no cap) - you must win by 2 points.
- The third game of the Best of Three Matches will be played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points (no cap).

F. Tournament Format

- All teams will begin the tournament in either Division 1 or 2 based on final standing from Sask Cup 1.

FORMAT

1. Initial **Pool** play – (see matches #1 to #28 on master draw).

2. After each initial **Pool**:

a) **1st Pool C** will play **1st Pool D** (match #29) to determine #1 and #2 seeds for **Division 1 playoffs** (match #36 to #47).

b) **teams** finishing **2nd, 3rd or 4th** in **Pool C** and **Pool D** will cross over, (match #30 to #35), against **teams** that finish **1st, 2nd or 3rd** in **Pool E** and **Pool F**.

- **winning teams** will advance to **Division 1 playoffs**, (match #36 to #47) beginning on **Sunday**.

- **losing teams** will advance to **Division 2 playoffs**, (match #48 to #61), on **Sunday**

c) **teams** finishing **4th or 5th** in **Pool E** and **Pool F** will advance to **Division 2 playoffs**, (match #48 to #61).
