## TOURNAMENT NOTES

### A. SEEDING

- Teams are seeded based on team declaration if they were Highly Competitive or Competitive

### B. TOURNAMENT RULES

- All 2017-18 Volleyball Canada Rules will be in effect for this tournament.
- The **Mikasa MVA200** will be the official competition ball for this age category.
- Teams must have numbered Jerseys

### C. CHECK-IN

- Team contacts must check in their team in the results room prior to their first match. The results room is behind Court 12.

### D. OFFICIATING

- Your team will provide Minor Officials for each game in which you are scheduled to play. You must provide 1 Scorekeeper and 1 Linesperson per match. These players are still eligible to play and may be substituted in to play. You may wish to have volunteers take care of this duty for your team.



## E. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Based on Volleyball Canada Rules, if two or more teams are tied at the end of round robin play, the following criteria will be applied in order:
  - a) The team having the best ratio of **won/lost MATCHES**, considering matches **between the TIED TEAMS**, will be ranked higher;
  - b) The team having the best ratio of **won/lost GAMES**, considering matches played **between the TIED TEAMS**, will be ranked higher;
  - c) The team having the best ratio of **won/lost GAMES**, considering **ALL matches of the round**, will be ranked higher;
  - d) The team having the best ratio of **points for/against**, considering **GAMES played between the TIED TEAMS**, will be ranked higher;
  - e) The team having the best ratio of **point for/against**, considering **ALL games played** during the round, will be ranked higher;
  - f) As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)

## F. MATCH PREPARATION

- Please have your team ready to play on time. Once all teams have played one match, you will have only a five-minute ball warm up on court before the start of your next match. This time allotment may be reduced at the discretion of the on-court officials and tournament organizers if the tournament is running behind schedule.
- Your co-operation would be appreciated in moving our tournament ahead of schedule if the opportunity presents itself.
- All games shall start on time as scheduled. Failure of a team to be ready to play at the scheduled time will be penalized by the loss of the first set by forfeit. A further 15 minutes will be allowed before the forfeiture of the second set.
- Teams must supply their own warm up balls.
- Coaches please fill in your rosters and sign the score sheet prior to each match.

## G. MEDICAL ROOM

- There will be a medical room on-site for athletes requiring first-aid. If athletes anticipate requiring attention, they are encouraged to bring their own supplies (i. e., tape).
- There will be a **\$5 charge per roll** of tape if an athlete does not have her/his own tape.

## H. PHOTOS

- TeamWorks Photo will be taking a Team Photo of every team at the event for the Sask Volleyball archives. You will receive an email early in the week prior to the tournament, indicating a timeslot that has been reserved for your team. The assigned time will be either immediately before or after one of your matches early in the tournament. If that scheduled time doesn't work for you, you can drop in to the TeamWorks Photo booth and they will fit you in.
